Guidelines for Poster Presentations

Overview

A poster presentation is a succinct, visual display that conveys information to interested individuals in an easily comprehended format. Poster presentations are held in a designated area of the Exhibit Hall or other common area. During the exhibit times, you will be asked to stand by your poster and answer questions or discuss your project with colleagues who share similar interests.

One to four sections of poster board can be used, depending on the amount of information to be conveyed. The space allotment is usually a 2 X 6 foot table, which holds a 4 foot poster comfortably. Two- to four- part posters that collapse into the manageable size of one poster board are easier to transport. Sturdy, thick poster board will allow a poster of two or more hinged sections to stand freely without extra supports. An uncluttered, readable, visually appealing poster will attract participants so you may share your ideas with them. The following content areas may be addressed in your poster presentation:

- Title
- Author(s)
- Introduction/overview
- Problem, hypothesis, objective, program description
- Intervention plan, steps of implementation
- Evaluation of results or outcomes

Guidelines

- Poster presentations are to be set up prior to the first opening of the Exhibit Hall.
- Presenters are responsible for mantling and dismantling of displays.
- Presenters should be present during presentation times, during off times, display will remain in view.
- Display will be on standard white display boards and should not exceed four feet in diameter and height. Standard stanchion size is 24" x 28". Non-commercial brochures/handouts may be distributed.
- Commercially driven presentations are prohibited.
- Information presented must contain information pertinent to nurses in long term care and/or assisted living.
- No more than two (2) individuals should be stationed at the display.
- Poster presenters are invited to attend the conference at half the registration fee.
